


Connecting to the FTP server

This article describes how to connect to the WebSell FTP. File transfer protocol server (commonly known as FTP Server) is computer software that facilitates the secure exchange of files over a TCP/IP network. This is necessary for the correct functioning of your webstore.

Steps:

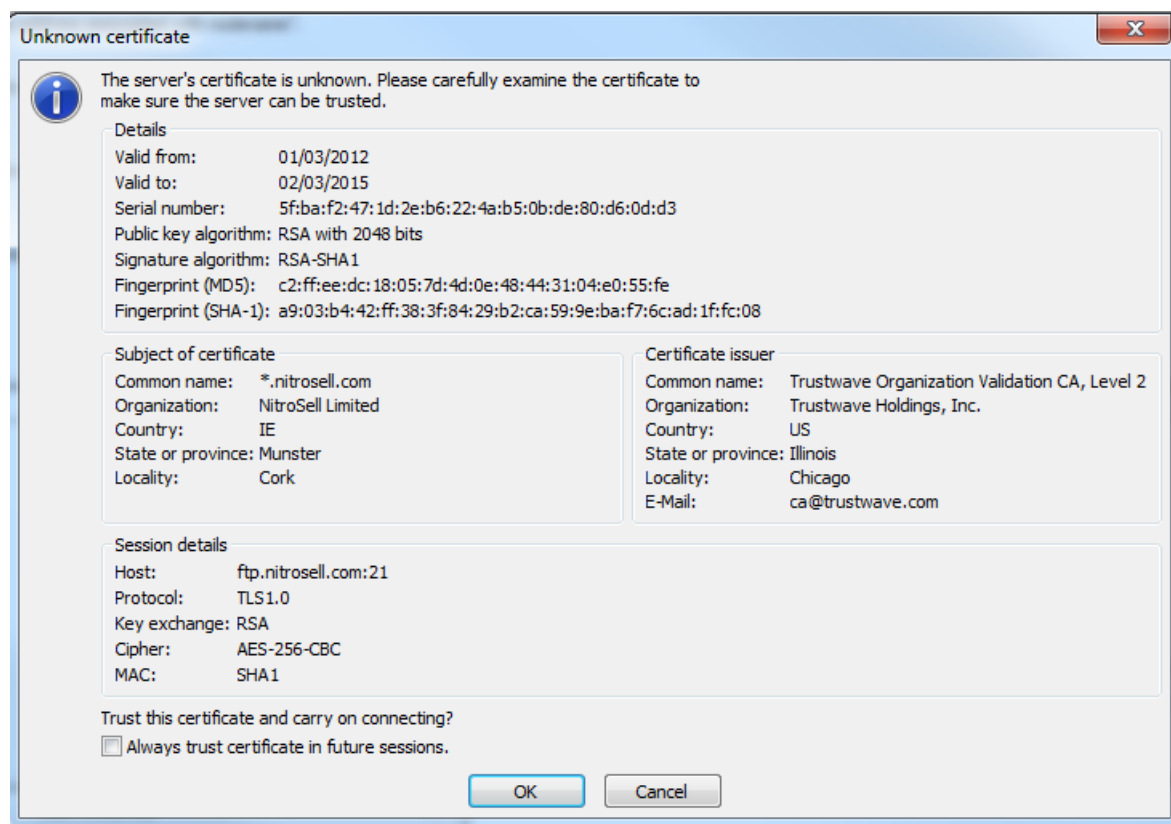
1. Open your FTP client (we recommend using FileZilla).
2. Navigate to the 'Host' input box.
3. Fill in your FTP credentials here (the 'Port' field will automatically be filled):
