


Account Payments

WebSell allows customers to make **account-based payments** directly through the webstore.

Customers with an assigned account can **view their current balance at checkout** with the **credit limit populated from Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central**. If the order total exceeds the available credit, the account payment option will not be available, ensuring purchases remain within approved limits.




